Use of Electronic Devices

(EC 48901.5)

Cassette players, walkmans, radios, games, beepers, IPODs, MP3s, CD players, cameras, and similar devices will not be permitted on campus for the following reasons:

1. They serve no educational purpose;
2. They are a distraction in the classroom; and
3. They are items that, due to their value, are often stolen or damaged.

Any of the items above that are brought on campus without permission of the principal, or designee, will be confiscated. They will be returned only to a parent or guardian and the school will not be responsible for items not picked up by a parent within one school week of confiscation.

Confiscated, lost or stolen articles will be stored in the office for four weeks after they have been turned into the office.

Any unclaimed items are then donated to a local charity.

The school will not be responsible for damage or loss to any personal item brought on campus.
